



Summer Scholarship Policy

The Ahtna Heritage Foundation (TAHF) was created to assist Ahtna shareholders in meeting their educational goals. The Summer Scholarship funds Ahtna shareholders who are either full or part-time students. Funding for the Summer Scholarship is generously provided by Ahtna Incorporated and other donors.

TAHF may fund at the following levels, on a first come first serve basis, subject to funding availability:

- **Part-time status \$1,000**
- **Full-time status \$2,000**

Status is to be defined by each individual institution.

Each semester attended counts as one measurement of the academic year; regardless of part-time or full-time status. For example, two semesters typically counts as one academic year.

- Undergraduate – an applicant may apply for up to five (5) academic years.
- Graduate – an applicant may apply for up to five (5) academic years.
- Total Scholarship Investment per Shareholder will be Ten (10) academic years.

Eligibility

The following requirements must be met to receive the summer scholarship:

New Applicants:

- Complete & signed application received by **May 15**
- Ahtna shareholder (Original or L Stock)
- High school graduate or GED
- Letter of acceptance to an accredited college, university or vocational school, or accepted in a program specializing in a recognized area of field of study
- Official proof of enrollment and registration, detailing your semester class units/credits.
- Official transcripts received by TAHF by **July 1**
- Minimum of 2.00 GPA or higher as a high school or college student (not applicable as GED recipients)
- One page essay describing your personal goals
- Two letters of recommendation

Renewal Applicants:

- A complete & signed application
- Provide Official Proof of Enrollment and Registration, detailing your semester class units/credits.
- Official transcript

Application Process

Deadline for application scholarship form is **May 15**

All applicants must reapply each summer.

New applicants will complete the new applicant scholarship form.

Renewal applicants will complete the renewal applicant scholarship form.

Awards are disbursed to the institutions only, not directly to the student.

Students must maintain a 2.0 GPA per semester funded. Cumulative GPA is only to be used for new applicants. If the 2.0 GPA is not met the applicant is denied. An applicant that is denied for not adhering to the 2.0 GPA must pay for a semester by means of their own and maintain a 2.0 GPA in that semester to be eligible for the WCMS.

- Application scholarship form must be timely received by the application deadline (see definitions)
- Applications will only be accepted when sent to the official application address, fax number or email address on the application form.
- Late application scholarship form not received by the deadline will not be approved.
- An exception to the deadline will be considered by the scholarship committee on a case by case basis for applications received within 14 days of the deadline. To be considered for an exception the applicant must submit, within 14 days of the application deadline, evidence of a dire emergency in the immediate family.

Appeal Process

Applicant can appeal a denial by sending a letter to the Executive Director within 14 days of the date of the denial letter. This can be mailed, faxed or e-mailed to the address on the application. The Executive Director will forward appeals to the scholarship committee with recommendations. Decision from the scholarship committee will be Final.

Definitions

New applicants- are first time applicants who have not been previously awarded or a returning student who has not re-applied within the past 2 years.

Returning applicants- are applicants who have been awarded a scholarship and are re-applying within 2 years.

Immediate Family- Husband and Wife, which include separated or divorced Parents and Children: Related by Blood, Marriage, or Legal Actions, Sisters and Brothers: Related by Blood, Marriage, or Legal Actions, Significant Other: Person(s) Living Together or Sharing the Same Household.

Dire emergency-a serious accident, illness or death in the immediate family.

Academic Year- TAHF understands that some universities or colleges break their academic year into units. If the academic year is not clearly explained on the applicant's paperwork, staff will follow up with the institution of higher learning for clarification.

Application Deadline-The date that applications are due are set by the scholarship committee. Currently May 15

Timely Receipt of Applications.

- Applications may be mailed, hand delivered, emailed or faxed to the correct address noted on the application.
- Mailed applications must be postmarked and the stamp cancelled by the application deadline.
- Hand delivered items must be received in the TAHF office by 5 pm on the application deadline and stamped received and initialed by a staff member.
- Fax and e-mail applications will be confirmed by the time stamp on the e-mail or fax and must be received by 11:59 PM of the application deadline.

I understand that the Ahtna Heritage Foundation Scholarship Committee will consider exceptions to the two above conditions (low GPA or incomplete classes) only in rare cases of extreme personal hardship during the last semester, including but not limited to, death in your close family, personal illness, and other personal hardship; and that a detailed letter of explanation and appropriate documents is required.

I understand my application and signature must be postmarked by the deadline. If my application is received after the Fall or Spring semester deadline, it will not be approved. I also understand that there is no exception to the deadline except in rare cases of extreme personal hardship during the last semester, including but not limited to, death in your close family, personal illness, and other personal hardship; and that a detailed letter of explanation and appropriate documents is required.

I understand that Ahtna Heritage Foundation must receive all other documents by the **JULY 1.**

I authorize Ahtna Heritage Foundation and Ahtna Inc. to release my name in connection with any public announcement of scholarship award. I also authorize Ahtna Heritage Foundation to share my information to Ahtna Inc. Subsidiaries for future intern or job placement.

I understand that the scholarship, if awarded, will be paid directly to the institute, college, university, or program at which I am enrolled and registered.
